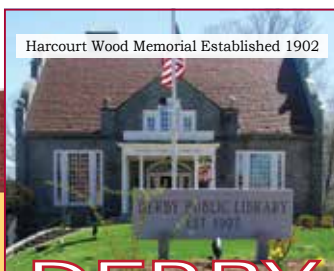

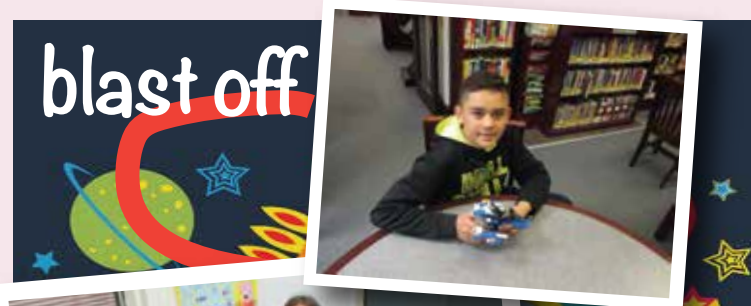

Best news: no late fees as all titles will automatically expire at the end of the lending period. Stop in to obtain or renew your Derby Public Library card.

If you are traveling to a foreign country, download the library's **Mango** language app for free from your device's app store! With over 70 languages available, you can brush up on commonly-used phrases prior to departure or even en route to make it easier to navigate once outside the U.S. We like the voice comparison feature which matches your pronunciation with native-speaker audio.
