Sealed bids for construction of Infiltration / Inflow Rehabilitation: Phase 2 Project for the City of Derby, Connecticut acting through it Water Pollution Control Authority, will be received at 1 Elizabeth Street, City Hall, WPCA Office, Derby, Connecticut, 06418 until 10:00 a.m. prevailing time, on April 29, 2019 at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted. Bids submitted after this date and time will be deemed to be invalid. All bids shall be submitted at the sole cost and expense of the bidder.

The scope of work for this project includes, but is not limited to, the removal and replacement of existing sewer mains and manholes as shown in the contract drawings to repair and seal multiple cracks and holes which are leaking or have the potential to leak.

There is a refundable deposit of \$50 per set payable to BidDocs Online Inc. Deposits may be electronically paid or must be a certified or cashier's check. Bidders requesting Contract Documents to be mailed to them shall include a separate check for \$40.00 per set for UPS Ground (or \$65.00 per set for UPS overnight), payable to the BidDocs Online Inc., to cover mail-handling costs.

A PRE-BID Conference will be held at 10:00 AM on April 16, 2019 at the 1 Elizabeth Street, City Hall, Second Floor - Aldermanic Chambers. Any request for interpretation of plans and specifications may be submitted in writing at that time and per the requirements listed in the Instructions to Bidders. Bidders will have an opportunity to view the site of the work following the Pre-bid Conference.

Bid Security in the form of a bid bond, cash, certified check, treasurer's or cashier's check payable to the Owner, is required in the amount of five percent of the bid, in accordance with Section 00200, INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any technical defects in the bids; to reject bids that do not conform to the terms and conditions described in the specifications; to reject any, any part of, or all bids; to waive informalities or irregularities in the bidding process; and to accept that bid which the Owner deems to be in its best interest.
