Derby Economic Development Project Update Report

September 2025

ACTIVE PROJECTS

Pedestrian safety Improvement projects

- Public hearing approved \$250,000 for pedestrian safety Improvement projects on Route 34 funded by Connecticut Connectivity Grant (CCGP) approved by CTDOT in 2018. Luchs Consulting Engineers will create RFP for bid of work approved by DOT. Project will provide crosswalks on Route 34 (across from Gilbert St and Bank St.) and at Sodom Lane.
- Public hearing approved \$3.86 Million Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTICIP) grant on Division Street and Seymour Avenue Pedestrian for safety improvements. Luchs Consulting Engineers will complete design details and initiate RFP.

Transit Oriented Development (TOD)

- City Hall meeting with David Kooris, Executive Director of CT Municipal Development Authority (CMDA) to discuss grants and low interest loans for upcoming downtown housing projects. Our goal, with CMDA support, is to complete some 500 housing units in the Derby TOD Zone with appropriate % of Affordable units.
- Construction of 105 housing units at Trolley Pointe is complete; 75% of Apartments are occupied after three months on the market. Historical Plaque installed on property recognizing its history. 100% of Cedar Village 90 units are now occupied.
- Redevelopment of the Shelton -Derby Railroad station has started. A \$25 Million renovation to provide improved transit facilities and services.
- Route 34 downtown widening DOT project downtown has been completed

O'Sullivan's Island Recreational Area/Derby Greenway

- Awarded DEEP (\$156,000) and EPA (\$200,000) grants submitted by Economic Development to assess remediation alternatives for O'Sullivan's Island (OSI). A title search confirmed City of Derby ownership of LOT 5 (Parcel 835) which is the final document required by DEEP
- Board of Alders moved to adopt a resolution to enter into an agreement with Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments to administer the two grants. NVCOG will be drafting an RFP to seek Environmental Engineering Consultants.
- UCONN completed and presented a Municipal Assistance Program (MAP) identifying potential recreational uses of O'Sullivan's Island. Report shared with Property & Development Committee confirms the recreational opportunities for OSI.

2026 Derby Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD)

- Economic Development Drafted RFP for review by Administration and Planning & Zoning Commission for the update of the 2016 POCD prior to posting RFP bid for Planning Consultants. City of Derby 2026-2036 POCD is scheduled for adoption in May 2026

Derby Parking Garage – Sale and Repurposing .

- Single bid received for lease, renovation and repurpose with some 54 apartments on additional floors of the city parking garage. Roof Top solar has been proposed. Due diligence in process. Potential for CMDA financial support as a City owned property is being actively pursued

Expansion of Derby Landfill (1.5MW-4.0 MW) Ground-Based Solar Systems

- Planning & Zoning Commission gave CGS 8-24 approval on August 5th for augmenting generating capacity of existing solar system by addition of battery energy storage systems. (BESS)
- Board of Alders approved Landowner consent for Green Derby LLC on August 14th to add 4MW of battery energy storage systems to the existing

solar installation on the Derby transfer station. Green Derby are in technical discussions with United Illuminating for Bid platform submission deadline of September 15th

- Board of Alders selected Davis Hill Development as the winning bid for expansion of solar energy generating facility (SEGF) at Derby Transfer Station. UI Bld platform is in discussion for Non-Residential Energy Solutions (NRES) which opened on August 4th and also closes on September 15th.
- Both projects, if approved by UI, would be at no cost to the city and contribute around \$130,000 per year from renewable energy generated on the city Transfer Station... for 20 years. (\$2.6 million)

Exploratory Projects

- We have submitted CIF-7 grant for \$250,000 for Infrastructure Planning for Fountain Lake Industrial Park and initiated discussions with Fuel Cell Energy of Danbury to construct a 10MW-20MW MW fuel cell that could provide power, 24/7, through a micro grid to a potential small-mid size data center and other manufacturers located within Fountain Lake Industrial park.
- 155 New Haven Avenue has been sold to an expanding local HVAC Contractor; plans have been presented and approved by P&ZC.
- Chase Bank are working with P&ZC to repurpose the former Starbucks property at 552 New Haven Avenue with drive through modifications with planned occupancy in Spring 2026.

The cost for this work is estimated to be more than \$60K and will require 30 – 40 days to complete. Engine 14 is not one of the apparatus to be replaced with the proposed Referendum Bond funds.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): SCBA

The approved Capital Plan includes funding to begin replacement of outdated SCBA equipment.

Facilities:

Fire Alarm Tower – 74 Cottage Street

This project continues in progress at the Fire Alarm Headquarter Building located at this address. The building renovation project is expected to be completed early Fall..

Two Way Radio System Upgrade

Funds necessary to replace the current two way radio send and receive units are included in the 5 year Capital Plan approved to be included in the pending Referendum Bond.

Operations

Please reference the Case & Time reports included with this narrative. During the month of February, the department responded to four structure fires in occupied structures. The department operated with great skill and in a professional manner. Thankfully, there were no fatalities or injuries to civilians and one minor firefighter injury.

Training:

The Department conducted a Live Burn Fire training drill at the Michael E. Grant Fire School in New Haven on August 21. 35 members participated.

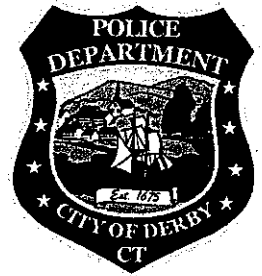

- Officers assisted NPL, a subcontractor for Eversource, with traffic control as the company continued overnight gas line installation along Derby Ave throughout the month. Officers made (2) DUI arrests of vehicles traveling through the construction zone. Additionally, Officers encountered several incidents of a BMW intentionally and reckless driving through construction zone. Great job to all of the officers working the assignment for identifying a potential suspect. The investigation has led to the suspect's vehicle being seized and warrants are being applied for the suspect.
- On 8/11/25 an animal cruelty arrest warrant was made on a Hamden female for abandoning her dog on Prindle Ave in July. Happy to report the dog has returned to health and has been adopted by a Derby Police officer.
- On 8/22/25 Officers were dispatched to Anson Street for reported gun shots at approximately 1:00 PM in the afternoon. The investigation determined a male opened fire on another male who then returned fired. Our Detective Bureau retrieved evidence including videos of the incident and are currently attempting to identify the suspects. There were no injuries reported and a parked, unoccupied vehicle sustained damage.
- On 8/24/25 a warrant arrest was made of a Wolcott male stemming from a 2024 street takeover that occurred on Pershing Drive.
- On 8/31/25 midnight shift responded to a report of males breaking into vehicles on Anson Street. Upon arrival, Officer Schmaling engaged the suspects in a foot pursuit. A 17-year-old juvenile male resident was arrested. The police investigation determined the suspect arrived in a stolen vehicle and was in the process of attempting to steal another vehicle.

Monthly Report to Mayor DiMartino, Re: Derby Public Library

For August 2025

The Derby Public Library is open to the public 47 hours a week, (with no Saturday hours during the months of July and August, Saturday hours to resume during the school year). The collection consists of over 63,381 items including books, DVDs, CDs, audiobooks, magazines, newspapers, and online databases. Outside books and A/V drops are open 24/7 for people to return their items. There are 3 full-time staff members and a part-time library staff of 9, as well as 2 part-time custodians. The Derby Public Library is a member of the Bibliomation Consortium which connects us to over 68 other libraries in the state of Connecticut.

- Circulation: 1129 items checked out at DPL; 313 Derby items were CO at other libraries, 92 items CO at DPL owned by other libraries
- Items added to collection: 104
- Total number of items: 63,381
- Door count: 3948
- Wi-fi users: 317
- Reference questions for Adults/Teens/Children (in person/phone/email): 483
- New library cards issued: 20
- Active Library card users: 1992

The August summer library programs and events for children and teens and adults winded down and culminated with end-of-summer celebrations. The Children's Department continued to host Friday morning movie screening, featuring popular children's films that drew strong attendance. Regular early literacy and enrichment programs remained throughout the month, including Baby Steps, Playdough Play, and the Built It Lego program.

Creative programming also remained a highlight. The popular adult crafter, Abi Rivellini, returned for a 2-day Intro to Sewing class for tweens, where participants learned how to use sewing machines and created their own fabric pillows. The following week another adult crafter, Vanessa Fasanelia returned host a jewelry program for middle schoolers and high schoolers. Attendees learned basic jewelry making techniques using bead boards, beads, and charms to design their own earrings, bracelets and/or necklaces. Smiles all around for the various pieces that were made that afternoon. In addition, the children's library assistants introduced a trivia day and family game night in the late afternoon and early evening however, there were few participants. The Read Aloud program with Ms. Ann Mirisola was unfortunately cancelled due to little attendance and the last Tween Book Club was held in August.

The Sliver Sluggers meeting with Rich Marazzi continued and was streamed on Facebook Live for the summer. During August the sluggers met in the Cohen Lobby on the main floor due to the extensive heat on the upper level, reaching over 90 degrees during one week in August, and consistently recording anywhere between 80 and 85 degrees during the entire month of August.

The 70th Anniversary of the 1955 Naugatuck Valley Flood photography exhibit and reception took place on the anniversary date of the first flood that year on Tuesday, August 19th at 2:00pm, with an introduction by the library director and local history coordinator, Christine Boulay. Through the generous donation of the family of Harold B. Yudkin, the glass negatives were archived and photographs were printed and on display for the month. In addition, the documentary "Highwater Mark" was also screened. We were fortunate to have several audience members attend who remembered where they were during the flood and shared their stories. Local history coordinator collected flood stories for preservation and added these written testimonials and histories to the DPL archives.

Derby Public Library staff continue to screen Oscar nominated films and popular movies weekly on Tuesdays during the month of August. Publicity Coordinator, Bennett, held two sessions for an Intro to Dungeons and Dragons for Adults with the first session reached maximum capacity, reflecting an interest in the program. Circulation manager, Kathy Wilson's, long standing book discussion group held the last Thursday of each month at 1pm. August's book discussion title, The Berry Pickers by Amanda Peters. Technology/reference librarian, Marc Weissman offered resume help and tech time by appointments on alternating Tuesday afternoons, and Thursday mornings. The director led an August book discussion at the Derby Senior Center on the first Wednesday of the month. The book discussed was, The Invisible Husband of Frick Island by Colleen Oakley. The Book to Screen program continued with "Moonflower Murders" by Anthony Horowitz, a 20-30 minute book chat followed by a screening of Season 2, with two (2) episodes every Monday at 5 PM in the Cohen Lobby.

The library staff and library board held a small retirement gathering in honor of Children's Librarian, Sue Sherman. She was honored for her 20 years of dedication to Derby Public Library's youngest patrons and their families.

In library maintenance news: Eli Electric replaced and installed emergency exit signs throughout the library on Saturday, August 6, Peter L from Bibliomation installed and upgraded the Envisionware software on the library's computers, routine visits from TK Elevator and Mass Fire Tech were also scheduled toward the end of the month.

August 2025 Report to City of Derby:

Total calls EMS for the Month of November were 202 in Derby and 21 mutual aid calls. Rescue 18 went on 49 calls, a mix of additional medical calls (when both of our ambulances were busy).

We responded to 3 medical emergencies on trails in Osbornedale State Park. This necessitated the use of a significant amount of personnel to locate the victims, then carry them to a trail and then out using our specially outfitted ATV for transporting patients.

The Storm Ambulance received a \$26,000.00 grant to purchase and operate Drones. They will enhance searches like those done in the state park, and available to any City agency that needs an overview of terrain. FAA operator licensing is in process to operate them.

**Board of Alderman Report August 2025
Water Pollution Control Authority**

Plant – The plant is operating within permit limits. Both new plant blowers are operational.

Plant Upgrade – In 2014 the city passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used to replace the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars.

Collections System – Operating without issues. We Jet cleaned 1,000ft and CCTV'ed 3,800ft of city sewer main.

Pump Station – All four pump stations are operating without issue.
