Derby Economic Development Project update report

January 2025

ACTIVE PROJECTS

Rehabilitation of Derby Greenway Pedestrian Bridge

- Luchs Engineering has completed the review of the ATANE Final Design Package for the Greenway Bridge repair and are now in conversation with ATANE regarding the preparation of an RFP, which should be posted for bid response in early New Year

Site reuse of Main Street South

- City has signed a purchase contract with the Jacobs' family for the sale of the Rubino scrap yard to the City and Federal funding is in place for the purchase and relocation of the scrapyard.
- A Phase 3 inspection for residual contaminants under the scrap pile was initiated during December.
- A site on Commerce St has been visited and meets the future needs of Rubino.
- We are assisting the existing owner (commercial vehicle storage yard) acquire a potential relocation site.

Trolley Pointe (90 Main Street) & Cedar Village (67-71 Minerva St)

- Trolley Pointe, 90 Main Street, should be open to residents in early 2025, has 105 units, 62 studios, 39 1-bedroom units and 4, 2-bedroom units.
- Under an agreement with the CT Commissioner of Housing, 27 units (26%) will receive a state subsidy to provide for workforce housing, (below market rate) the balance will be at a market rate.
- Cedar Village, which was open for rental applications in October, already has all of 90 Units contracted.

Derby's Fountain Lake Industrial Park

- In partnership with CEDS/NVCOG and the Regional Director of the Federal Economic Development Administration (EDA), we have determined that the

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City should apply for an EDA Technical Assistance grant for the design and construction of the infrastructure for roads, water, natural gas and sewer services to Derby's Fountain Lake industrial park.

- Work is in progress on the grant application with NVC-EDD - Grant documentation required is extensive and will likely require approval from both Derby and Ansonia legislatures.
- We are in active discussion with a fuel cell provider, and with United Illuminating, as a potential significant 'revenue anchor' for the industrial park.

Block Family Trust land (38 Great Hill Road)

- A multi-phase site redevelopment plan is being discussed prior to a January P&Z meeting to address rezoning from the prevailing Industrial Campus (I-C) zoning.

CT Main Street Center (CMSC)

- The Executive Director of CMSC is assisting the City with a \$150,000 Training & Technology grant application to USDA for funding a program to address "revitalizing downtown Derby".
- David Kooris, the newly appointed Executive Director of CT Municipal Redevelopment Authority (MRDA) to City Hall, invited Derby to opt-in to the state sponsored program to support transit-oriented housing developments, (TOD) like Main Street South, etc.

Parking Garage update

- We have continued exploratory conversations with an interested private buyer of the City owned parking garage who has assessed its condition, including structural analysis, and indicated a serious interest in accommodating additional floors for some 52 residential units and potentially retail on the ground floor.



Derby Landfill update

- We have been in conversation BQEnergy, who operate the current solar installation on the Derby landfill, which generated net income of \$43,000 in 2024. They have proposed to add (at no cost to the City) 4MW of battery energy storage units to the solar system. This would extend the hours of power exported to UI grid by 4 hours per day and add \$25,000 per year to the City energy credits. We will be presenting this proposal to the Property and Development sub-committee in January and BoAA in February.
- BQEnergy have also proposed to the City an application to UI and the DEEP Siting Council (which requires Landowner Consent by the BoAA- deadline mid-February 2025), for an addition of 4MW of solar panels, which would add a further \$50,000 per year for 25 years to the revenues paid to the City.

O'Sullivan's Island (OSI) Update

- A \$156,000 grant application, co-developed by Economic Development and Environmental Engineers, Tighe & Bond, has been submitted to DEEP for an assessment of remediation requirements to make OSI a safe passive recreational area.
- We have been approached by the owners of Scoot & Paddle for a return of their Kayak, Paddle board & Bike rental service to OSI in 2025. A proposal is expected for review at the January Property & Development sub-committee.
- In their 2023 season located on OSI, Scoot & Paddle recorded 2,500 customers/visitors to Derby.

Division Street upgrade

- Economic Development coordinated with Luchs Consulting Engineers and Griffin Health, the final plans for the upgrade of roads and sidewalks around Griffin Hospital.
- A \$3.1m LOTSIP grant application to DOT has been prepared by Luchs.

155 New Haven Ave

Met with prospective purchaser (wholesale bakery) and realtor with potential for 20-25 new jobs

Derby/Shelton Rotary Club

Economic Development was the invited guest speaker to their December meeting.

There was an active discussion around Economic Development 3-year targets including plans for increasing Derby property tax revenues and moving the % of revenue towards commercial/industrial and lessening dependence on residential property tax revenues.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

The Department has made great progress through the duration of 2024. With the approval for the expenditure of the Aarp funding for new turnout gear, the department successfully secured new gear for all Interior Certified members early in the year. We continue to monitor the inventory for cleanliness & maintenance. Currently, the annual deep cleaning is scheduled for March 2025.

Facilities:

Fire Alarm Tower – 74 Cottage Street

The department is continuing the process to secure contractors and vendors to renovate the structure with funds recommended by the Capital Planning Commission and approved by the Board of Alderman/Woman.

Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Application: Apparatus Exhaust Removal System

The application has been submitted to FEMA with assistance of the City Grant writer on December 20. If awarded, the project will include the supply and installation for nine systems in the City's four firehouse facilities. The project Cost is \$136,550.00.

IT:

The department has purchased new desktop computers for each of the four fire companies. The computers will be set up at each firehouse. Additionally, three laptop computers will be assigned for Training, SCBA fit testing and the Safety officer. We look forward to getting this equipment online to improve our current abilities for record keeping, training and safety.

Operations:

Please reference the Case & Time reports included with this narrative. During the month of December, the department responded to four structure fires in occupied structures, including (2) in the City of Shelton, (1) in Ansonia and (1) in Derby. The department operated with great skill and in a professional manner. Thankfully, there were no fatalities or injuries to civilians and one minor firefighter injury.

Training:

Training is an very important component of every member's service to the community. Each of the four fire companies train three Thursday evenings each month. All companies train together at department sponsored training, typically on the third Thursday of each month. The training may include some classroom instruction, and hands on skilled set. The department also provides live burn training, typically offered at the Michael E. Grant Regional Fire Training School in New Haven. Most of the Department membership completed the annually required recertification in three Connecticut State Fire Academy skills and topics including SCBA, Hazardous Materials Operations & Bloodborne Pathogens. Additionally, Firefighters will complete annual medical clearance examinations in the coming months.

- It appears we have found a remedy to our baseball pitching mound problem. The cost for this repair is expected to be approximately \$5,000.00. This number is considerably better than previous quotes.
- As soon as the weather permits, our baseball/softball facilities will be fortified with field clay secured through the City's Capital Plan.
- After suffering for approximately 3 months with heating problems associated with the DVCC pool, we have repaired several HVAC issues that have plagued the systems. The repairs were costly and the maintenance line item in the budget will require contributions from other budget areas. This is a common occurrence and there is no reason for alarm.
- The Witek Park maintenance account has seen finance increases across the board with services provided there. This will be discussed during budget consultations for next year.
- **Recreation receivables as of January 6, 2025 is \$43,567.00.**

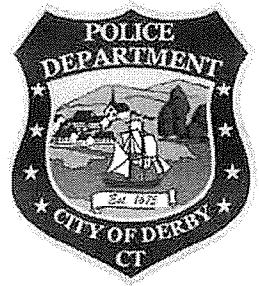

Monthly Report to Mayor DiMartino, Re: Derby Public Library

For December 2024

The Derby Public Library is open to the public **54** hours a week, (including 5 hours on Saturdays, year round). The collection consists of over 63,686 items including books, DVDs, CDs, audiobooks, magazines, newspapers, and online databases. Outside book and A/V drops are open 24/7 for people to return their items. There are 3 full-time staff members and a part-time library staff of 9, as well as 2 part-time custodians. The Derby Public Library is a member of the Bibliomation Consortium which connects us to over 68 other libraries in the state of Connecticut.

- Circulation: **1530 items checked out at DPL; 235 Derby items were CO at other libraries, 74 items CO at DPL owned by other libraries**
- Items added to collection: **76**
- Total number of items: **63,686**
- Door count: **2127**
- Wi-fi users: **147**

The weekly library class visits from Irving School of around 80 students continued in December, while St. Mary and St. Michael students from Kindergarten and 2nd grades made their first monthly visit. Our friends from the Disability Resource Network program continue to visit the library as well.

This fall the Library has seen its fair share of contractors who have maintained and repaired various areas in the library—the vent cleaning was completed on Wednesday, Dec 4 and the library was open to the public on Thursday, Dec 6 as projected. Additional repair work continued with Professional Restoration Systems on the upper level on December 11th and 12th. And a 3rd project started the following week on December 18th with NOVUS and Northeastern Communication and Electrical LLC to upgrade the fiber connection in the Library. This project continues and should be completed in mid-January.

The Friends of the Derby Public Library sponsored “Jingle All the Day” on Saturday, December 14. The family fun event was well received by those who stopped by the library for cookies and crafts. In attendance were a number of Friends of the Library and Library Board Members along with library staff who helped spread holiday cheer. A special thanks to crafter, Lisa Lupa and technology librarian, Marc W, who entertained all with holiday classics on the piano.

Silver Slugger host Rich Marazzi returned to the library on a Tuesday evening for a special author talk and book signing with his latest book, “Yankee Stories Untold” on December 17. A well turned out crowd was on hand to purchase copies and to hear about those Yankees.

The library director met with City Hall finance director, Brian H, Valley Community Foundation President and CEO Sharon C and Beth C, Donor Services Manager and WB Mason vendor.

December 2024 Report to City of Derby:

Total calls EMS for the Month of December are attached FD 10 and FD 9 Ambulances responded to 231 calls.

Rescue 18 responded to 50 calls, something not understood is Rescue 18 is also a medical response unit so when both of our ambulances are busy it responds to third medical calls and provides care until an ambulance can get to the patient.

Annual call numbers are attached to this report, the highlights are:

Emergency Medical calls for 2024 – 2884.

Rescue calls 530

Marine services- water rescue etc. 13

Haz-Mat responses 11

Numbers not captured here are football stand byes, River Regattas, training events (CPR etc.) and community events such as Derby days, 4th July fireworks etc.

Just a FYI to the board, we have now completed training of numerous members of Storm Ambulance as technicians:

- Confined space responses
- Rope and high angle rescues
- Hazardous Materials Technician training
- Trench Rescues
- Vortex victim removal systems
- Vehicle Extrication
- Annual EMS Continuing Education

All the technical Rescue courses were provided by NY City Fire Department trained instructors, Conn State Fire Academy and industry equipment specialists and CT DPH Emergency Medical Certified instructors. The current plan is to maintain a rotating schedule of continuing education.

EMS -On a 12-month cycle

Technical Rescue- on A 24-month cycle

Water rescue- 12-month cycle

Total volunteer hours to date are 212 per responder. This training is in addition to maintaining their Emergency Medical Services certifications and responding to calls.



We are taking part in a regional Haz-Mat exercise planned for later in 2025.

The plan to place an Emergency Medical Technician class in Derby High School is moving along with school officials. If completed and successfully passed students will graduate with 6 advanced college credit hours and a certification from the State of CT to work on an ambulance.

Storm Ambulance is seeking a replacement for our 30-year-old Rescue truck. Suggestions have been made to try to combine a Derby FD pumper and a full-size rescue truck into one vehicle. That idea has been found to be impractical for many reasons that will be presented to the Capitol Plan Committee.

We are completed our Team first responder "toys for tots drive" at Bj's wholesale club on December 7th from (9 AM to 1PM). It was a remarkable success.

We are in the process of upgrading our stretchers and Stair Chair equipment.
We are placing pet friendly oxygen masks and clotting agents on our vehicles.

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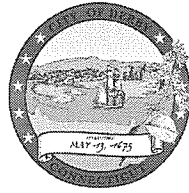

Plant – The plant is operating within permit limits. The new plant blower is running without issues.

Plant Upgrade – In 2014 the City passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used to replace the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars. New rotary press to be delivered December 3, 2024.

Collections System – Operating without issues.

Pump Station – All four pump stations are operating without issue
