ACTIVE PROJECTS

Main Street South Site Re-Use/Development Project:

• Route 34 Main Street widening completed mid-July. Some issues being resolved: \$250,000, Pedestrian Improvement Project Connecticut Connectivity Grant (CCGP) approved by CTDOT in 2018 has been revisited and design review completed and approved by DOT. Project will provide a cross walk on Route 34 (across from Gilbert St). Next step is preparation and release of RFP.

The sale of Rubino metal recycling center completed, details of proposed new location in legal review.

<u>Trolley Pointe Development (90 Main Street)</u>

Construction of 105 housing units is complete, initial occupancy in progress

O'Sullivan's Island Recreational Area/Derby Greenway

- Awarded DEEP (\$156,000) and EPA (\$200,000) grants to assess remediation alternatives.
- NVCOG drafting RFP to seek Consultant Environmental Engineers
- UCONN is conducting a Municipal Assistance Program (MAP) to identify potential recreational uses of O'Sullivan's Island, results will be presented in August
- Still awaiting RR response from City lawyers for expired lease of Greenway bridge pending its repair.
- Scoot & Paddle announced a Lake Housatonic Launch location at Indian Well State Park in Shelton after declining the lease offered by City of Derby.

<u>Derby Parking Garage – Sale and Repurposing</u>

• Single bid received for lease, renovation and repurposing with some 54 apartments on additional floors of the city parking garage.

Division St & Seymour Avenue Pedestrian safety improvements

- A public hearing was held for the proposed DOT project to address pedestrian safety improvements
- The total LOTCIP budget is \$3,863,000 for the Division St. & Seymour Ave. project.

Expansion of Derby Landfill (1.5MW-4.0 MW) Ground-Based Solar System

- The Board of Alders approved Green Derby LLC as the only bid to add 4MW of battery storage systems to the existing solar installation on Derby transfer station. Installation would take around 1/10th of an acre (0.25% of total land area) and increase City revenues from the landfill by an estimated 58%. Referred to Planning & Zoning Commission for CGS 8-24 approval on August 5th
- The Board of Alders selected Davis Hill Development as the winning bid for expansion of solar energy generating facility (SEGF) at Derby Transfer Station. UI bid platform for Non-Residential Energy Solutions (NRES) opens on August 4th and closes on September 15th
- Both projects would be at no cost to the city and contribute around \$130,000 per year for 20 years (\$2.6 million) from renewable energy generated at the city transfer station.

Exploratory Projects

- We have submitted CIF-7 grant for \$250,000 for Infrastructure Planning for Fountain Lake Industrial Park and had a conversation with execs of a proprietary, emission free, renewable energy solution (W2e) using recycled plastics, that can produce 30MW of power in a 30,000 SF building. United Illuminating is also involved with the City of Derby in this exploratory technology.
- We have submitted a USDA grant for \$50,000 for initiating a downtown Derby revitalization program in partnership with CT Main Street Center. (CMSC). Outcome expected this Fall and been awarded a Small Grant (\$2k) with matching requirements by Valley Community Foundation

Equipment repairs have begun with the renewal of the fiscal year this month. Despite the overrun of the equipment maintenance budget in the 2024-25 budget (\$32,000.00). total (\$132,000.00) repair issues continue to be identified with weekly inspections of apparatus. Each apparatus is assigned a Chief Driver whose responsibilities include light maintenance (cleaning, maintain fluids, regular startups and visual inspections, etc.). Additionally, each apparatus is inspected and documented annually by a certified mechanical technician for applicable Department of Transportation compliance. Likewise, the fire pumps and aerial ladder are inspected annually and documented to maintain the certifications for performance.

Currently, Engine 13 with issues including the Cooling System, Brake system, Electrical System, Air Condition, and Fire Pump Systems. Additionally, the Cabinet doors need adjustment to open and close, and the 4 rear tires require replacement. It does not sound like much in two sentences, however in real life, the work will cost over \$22,000.. Thankfully, replacement of Engine 13 is included in the proposed 5 Year Capital Plan. The repair work of all issues relative to safety and fire control have been prioritized and iin progress, although some parts are not expected to be delivered for several weeks.

The engine iwill be kept in service whenever feasible during the repair schedule to maximize availability for response to alarms.

The Cummins Diesel engine has been diagnosed to have a serious problem with the internal valves, requiring a complete rebuild of the engine (internal combustion). This repair will require Engine 14 to be out of service for 3-4 weeks. During this period of time, mutual aid engines will be dispatched to cover Engine 14 assignments.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): SCBA

The approved Capital Plan includes funding to begin replacement of outdated SCBA equipment.

- On 07/18/25 DPW discovered vandalism at the picnic grove and basketball courts located on Nutmeg Drive. Patrol determined a vehicle was involved in an accident that resulted in damage to the wooden fence at the picnic grove and damage to the basketball fencing. The operator failed to report the accident and patrol was able to identify the operator. A warrant is pending for the operator for evading motor vehicle accident.
- After 31 years as a supernumerary police officer, our last supernumerary, Stephen Iacuone has officially retired. We thank Stephen for his dedicated service to the City.
- On 7/30/25 Recruit Police Officer Kyle Frappier graduated from Milford's Police Academy. Frappier earned the Luciano Award for having the highest overall academic average. He begins his FTO this week.
- We are encountering an increasing number of issues related to the age and condition of our fleet, which is now affecting our operations. The department is experiencing a rising frequency of repairs to our fleet, many of which are no longer covered under warranty. We are at a point where we no longer have any spare vehicles to rotate in case of maintenance or repair needs. This has led to an overreliance on our remaining vehicles, resulting in increased wear and tear. Our spare vehicles, which were once available to temporarily replace those out of service, are now in the process of being sold through Property Room. This decision to sell was made due to substantial costs needed to repair these vehicles, which exceeds their current value. Having a well-maintained, reliable fleet is essential to the safety and efficiency of our officers, and ultimately to the safety of our community.

The Derby Public Library is open to the public 52 hours a week, (including 5 hours on Saturdays, during the school year). The collection consists of over 63,456 items including books, DVDs, CDs, audiobooks, magazines, newspapers, and online databases. Outside books and A/V drops are open 24/7 for people to return their items. There are 3 full-time staff members and a part-time library staff of 9, as well as 2 part-time custodians. The Derby Public Library is a member of the Bibliomation Consortium which connects us to over 68 other libraries in the state of Connecticut.

She was present with her family and was awarded the \$1,000.00 monetary gift and certificate by library board president Dorothy Gleason. Her name was also added to the winners plaque displayed in the Teen Zone. She is to attend Pace University in the fall and pursue a Business and Marketing degree. We wish her much success.

The children's department continued with their regular programing for our youngest patrons: babies and toddlers, and children. The Level Up summer reading program kicked off on Saturday, June 21st which also this year coincided with the birthday celebration of Harcourt Wood. His birthday was celebrated with a beautiful display of roses and a cupcake birthday cake for patrons and the public alike. Also, our own technology librarian provided the musical entertainment. We want to thank all those who stopped by: library board members, several 350th Derby committee members and the public who joined us for this yearly celebration since 1902. A special thank you to MarkAnthony Izzo who took some fabulous photos of Derby Public Library! In addition, the children's department continues with daily library programs and crafts during the summer months. Such as Baby Steps, Lego Time, Taste the Book, Sidewalk Chalk and Bubbles, and Read aloud with Ms. Ann Mirisola and Tween Book Club.

The Sliver Sluggers meeting with Rich Marazzi will continue on Facebook Live for the summer. You can now enjoy the sluggers meeting from the comfort of your own home

or any spot. Search Facebook for Derby Public Library and watch the meeting while it is live every other Thursday from 10am-12pm.

Derby Public Library staff continue to screen Oscar nominated films and popular movies on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month at 1pm. As of July 1st, the Tuesday movie matinees will be weekly for the months of July and August. And be sure to check out Kathy Wilson's long standing book discussion group held the last Thursday of each month at 1pm. June's book discussion title, The Wedding People by Allison Espach. Also, technology/reference librarian, Marc Weissman offers resume help and tech time by appointments on alternating Tuesday afternoons, and Thursday mornings. Director, Marianne Smertiuk, also lead a book discussion at the Derby Senior Center on the first Wednesday of the month. The first book discussed was, The Kitchen Front by Jennifer Ryan. This senior book discussion group will be held during the summer months.

Updates:



July 2025 Report to City of Derby:

Total calls EMS for the Month of July are attached and broken down by unit ID.

FD 10 and FD 9 Ambulance calls. 217 in Derby, twenty-19 mutual aid to other cities and 17 in Derby from other agencies when we were busy with other calls, and we were down an ambulance for repairs. Rescue 18 went out on 36 calls.

We also had one call for Hazardous Materials.

We responded to 3 calls on the Housatonic River for emergencies.

Our crew delivered 40 hours of coverage for the 4th of July fireworks staffing both ambulances, the ranger, rscue truck and admin staff.

Rope rescue and high angle rescue training was done in house.

Vehicle extrication classes were conducted on 2 Thursday evenings.

Storm Ambulance also with the Shelton and Ansonia Fire Departments, have received a grant to begin a Drone response system to be used in each community for rescues, location of missing persons, etc. It will be operated by FAA certified operators and should be ready to respond soon.

We partnered with Eagle Scout Keegan Goodwin who designed response location signs for people on the riverwalk. Previously when a call for assistance was made, we would have to estimate where the caller is and find them by going up and down the riverwalk. The signs instruct people to use the letter and number on a post; this information is relayed to the 911 dispatch center who then directs our ambulance personnel exactly where the caller is. Copies of the signs are included at the end of this report.

We are beginning to set up a regional mass casualty exercise for the City of Derby to assess the readiness of our emergency services and mutual aid partners.







Board of Alderman Report July 2025 Water Pollution Control Authority

Plant – The plant is operating within permit limits. The two new plant blowers are set in place and are currently being installed.

Plant Upgrade – In 2014 the city passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used to replace the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars.

Collections System - Operating without issues. We Jet cleaned 13,500ft of city sewer main

Pump Station – All four pump stations are operating without issue
