- The DMS soccer seasons have finished up. X-Country will compete at the State meet on Saturday 11/1






### Derby Economic Development Project Update Report

### November 2025

Connecticut has long been a hub of precision, innovation, and industrial excellence—and today, its advanced manufacturing sector continues to evolve at the forefront of global competitiveness. Next month, with participation of the newly appointed CT Chief Manufacturing Officer, Kirti Patel, we are exploring some of what makes Connecticut's advanced manufacturing sector exceptional and an engine for economic growth. We will be discussing the manufacturing industry's need for a constant pipeline of skilled workers and how the City of Derby is helping to meet that need.

### **ACTIVE PROJECTS**

### Pedestrian safety Improvement projects

- Luchs Consulting Engineers created an RFP for approved \$250,000 DOT project to provide crosswalks on Route 34 (across from Gilbert St and Bank St.) and at Sodom Lane.
- Luchs Consulting Engineers completed design details and will initiate RFP in November for the approved \$3.86 Million Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTCIP) grant on Division Street and Seymour Avenue for Pedestrian Safety Improvements. It is anticipated that the project will commence late 2025/early 2026

### Workforce Housing /Transit Oriented Development (TOD)

- Our goal, with CT Municipal Development Authority (CMDA) support, is to complete some 500 housing units in the Derby TOD Zone (1/2 mile from Derby-Shelton railroad station) with appropriate % of Affordable units.
   Currently with the occupancy of Cedar Village and Trolley Pointe, 14% of Derby housing qualifies as workforce housing
- We provided information for Griffin Health on local housing for health care personnel.

### Recreational site use for O'Sullivan's Island

 Board of Alders moved to adopt a resolution to enter into an agreement with Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments to administer the two grants (\$356,000) awarded to City of Derby for remediation assessment of OSI. RFP has been drafted by NVCOG and should be issued in early November — a site walk for interested Environmental Consultants has been scheduled by NVCOG

### 2026 Derby Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD)

• RFP has been posted for the update of the 2016 Derby POCD. Deadline for response is November 6<sup>th</sup> We have had conversations with several interested Planning Consultants.

### <u>Derby Parking Garage – Sale and Repurposing.</u>

• A revised RFP will be issued in November - there is now potential for CMDA financial support as a city owned property.

### Expansion of Derby Landfill (1.5MW-4.0 MW) Ground-Based Solar Systems

- Davis Hill Developments have been engaged by United Illuminating for 4MW expansion of renewable energy generating capacity of existing solar system at Derby Transfer Station.
- Green Derby LLC submitted its bid to United Illuminating to add 4MW of battery energy storage systems to the existing solar installation on the Derby transfer station.

### Community Engagement Projects

- The Leadership Greater Valley conference on Economic Development & The Region was held at Derby City Hall on October 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Speakers included Derby Economic Development, Shelton Economic Development Corporation and CT Small Business Development Center.

### **Manufacturing Showcase**

- Economic Development was invited to CT Manufacturers Innovation Forum, and, as a result, we were encouraged to organize a Regional Manufacturers Showcase at Derby Advanced Manufacturing Technology Center.
- With support from Derby HS, United Illuminating, CONNSTEP, RDA and CT Chief Manufacturing Officer, we will be featuring State manufacturing programs, which will be held at Derby Advanced Manufacturing Technology Center on November 12<sup>th</sup>

### **Other Activities**

- The CIF-7 grant for \$250,000 for Infrastructure Planning for Fountain Lake Industrial Park was declined, we are exploring a revised submission for Cif-8 due in December
- 155 New Haven Avenue has been sold to an expanding local HVAC Contractor; further tenants are envisaged. We have connected the new owners with a recently announced UI Economic Development rate for new businesses.
- We assisted the Planning Engineers presenting Chase Bank's plans to repurpose the former Starbucks property at 552 New Haven Avenue with drive through modifications with planned occupancy in Spring 2026.
- We have been invited by United Illuminating to partner with them for a
   DEEP request for proposals for grid resilience construction program, which
   could feature an energy generation facility on Derby's Fountain Lake
   Industrial Park.

The Fire Marshal's Office primary responsibility is to conduct Life Safety inspections throughout the city. The inspections include, but are not limited to, multi-family housing, business offices, mercantile, gas stations etc. The Office is responsible for plan reviews for any new construction, alterations and additions as well as commercial kitchen hoods, fire alarms and sprinkler systems.

Do to the recent resignation of one (1) part time inspector, the office is currently operating with just myself and one (1) other part time inspector.

## Monthly Report to Mayor DiMartino, Re: Derby Public Library

#### For October 2025

The Derby Public Library is open to the public 52 hours a week, (including 5 hours on Saturdays, during the school year). The collection consists of over 62,373 items including books, DVDs, CDs, audiobooks, magazines, newspapers, and online databases. Outside books and A/V drops are open 24/7 for people to return their items. There are 2 full-time staff members and a part-time library staff of 9, as well as 2 part-time custodians. The Derby Public Library is a member of the Bibliomation Consortium which connects us to over 68 other libraries in the state of Connecticut.

The Friends of Derby Public Library kicked off the month with a **Spooktacular** event on October 6<sup>th</sup> for our youngest library patrons. Children and families gathered in the children's department in costume to kick off the spooky season complete with crafts, Halloween treats, and a Squishmallow give-away. Regular library programs continue: Baby Steps every other Monday, Play Dough Play every other Friday, along with the popular Play Learn Create on alternating Friday mornings, and the reintroduction of Busy Bee Bags for our youngest prereaders, and Build It: Lego Club twice a month. The Children's Department also screened Holiday favorites and offered a craft on several Saturday mornings, and continued the popular Taste the Book program one Saturday per month.

On October 22 Irving School's 2<sup>nd</sup> graders held their community walk and stopped by the library and met with library director after their lunch with the Derby PD. What a wonderful group of students!

The director and librarians, Kathy Wilson and Marc Weissman, supported the Derby Police Department's Touch a Truck event on Saturday, Oct 25. It was a fabulous day with so many friends and new friends stopping by the library table for all kinds of treats. A wonderful day for library outreach—we can't wait to return next year! The library director hosted a special Halloween story time and parade for the younger patrons and their families on Friday, October 31. We want to thank all those who attended the morning story time.

Irving School, St Mary St Michael, and Disability Resource Network visits continued throughout the month of October.

Patrons of all ages also had the opportunity to decorate haunted houses. We had some wonderful submissions that were on display in the Children's Department and Reading Room. Congrats to winners Greyson (student) and Heidi W (adult) who won gift cards to Barnes and Noble! Young adults are encouraged to join Teen Librarian for Teen Game Time on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month after school, and stop in on the last Wednesday of the month for the

Teen Advisory Board meeting.

The Tuesday movie matinees continued with regular 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month schedule. The senior center fall book discussion with library director on the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of the month was well attended. The Silver Sluggers with Rich Marazzi are winding down the season and only a handful of Thursday meetings are left. The months of October and November bring guest speakers. A pop up craft event: Crafting with Christine, with local history coordinator, was a success. Attendees made a recycled harvest cork pumpkin.

Mid October, paranormal investigator Jeff Belanger presented on Ghosts and Legends (in New England) in the community room with almost 50 people in attendance. And local crafter, Lisa Lupa, led a popular decoupage craft program. The decoupage program was well received and reached full capacity and with a waitlist offered to patrons. The last Thursday of the month patrons enjoyed the book discussion of *The Frozen River* by Ariel Lawhon, led by Circulation Manager, Kathy Wilson.

In late September, well known library book vendor Baker & Taylor announced their upcoming closure. The Derby Public Library, like many libraries across the country, relied on B&T as a primary book vendor for decades. Libraries nationwide are working quickly to find alternative sources for book purchasing. Throughout the month of October, the library director researched several potential vendors and decided to move forward with Ingram as the new book supplier. We anticipate new materials on our library shelves soon. We would like to thank our patrons for their continued support and their patience during this transition.

Upcoming Library events: Register for **Turn back Trees** in the month of November, decorate your tree the first week of December, the public votes on the best tree with the winners announced in January. Decorate a blank Gingerbread House, displayed in the Children's and Reading Room, with winner announced mid-December. The Friends of Derby Public Library family event **Jingle All the Day** on Saturday, December 6 with local Giggling Pig Art Studio (\*registration required for the craft) come in for crafts, eggnog and cookies, and get cozy.

In library maintenance news: Calvert Safe and Lock installed the key system upgrade in the community and staff room. TKE Elevator Inspections on October 3, State Elevator Inspections on October 8, Controlled Air technicians stopped in to replace the filters and to check in on the outdoor units on October 22, and monthly fire extinguishers inspections on October 24.

#### October 1st – October 31st, 2025

- Garbage runs continue 3 times per week on both East & West side of Derby
- DPW continued to pick up biodegradable Leaf bags from January throughout the Summer which is outside of the
  normal seasonal period (from October- December). This was conducted at least 3 times per week for both East &
  West sides of Derby. Residents are continually being instructed to follow the City's ordinances and avoid rocks, turf
  and grass clippings and other items due to weight restrictions. This applies to items not accepted at the transfer
  station. This is managed frequently due to the continued calls & demands of residents.
- Clean up of Greenway-walk way area- crews manually weed-whacked specified areas as needed and to pick up garbage and other debris- manage issues at fountain.
- The DPW Street sweeper is assigned to cleaning both East & West sides of City based on the weekly schedule.
- Cut all Islands Weekly and All City Fields and surrounding areas and to manage alternating schedules for soccer fields
  versus football for changing the goal posts and other essentials. Regular maintenance of Widek park- cut & line fields
  as needed for both sports as assigned per the Athletic Directors schedule.
- DPW Crews completed the excavation and repairs as needed for 59 Belleview Drive for a compromised catch basin that shifted causing deterioration to the surrounding asphalt at the end of residents' driveway & street
- Crews continue to manage landscapes, Derby green, Route 34 center islands for weed removal and mow all fields as well as other sections in town as assigned
- DPW Tank Truck is still assigned to complete multiple fills for transport to the water barrels at the community gardens
   -this is conducted several times per week based on demand-or until seasons end
- DPW Crews completed the cut and removal of obstructed branches and other tree limbs from Cemetary Avenue area based on a resident's call.
- Received the delivery of remaining protective tops to City refuge containers- Crews assigned to assemble and place throughout city as needed to replace existing damaged or deteriated containers.
- DPW crews clean catch basins throughout town, repair mailboxes and cut roads as needed.
- Crews were assigned to work on roads at both Coppola Terrace. Paugussett Road and Sinkhole on Laurel place
- Repairs to Derby Green Gazebo, benches, and fence

- There was a 3-day trip to the Tropicana in Atlantic City. 30 people attended and remarked on how much fun they had.



## Board of Alderman Report October 2025 Water Pollution Control Authority

**Plant** – The plant is operating within permit limits.

**Plant Upgrade** – In 2014 the city passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used to replace the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars.

**Collections System** – Operating without issues. We Jet cleaned 4,900ft of city sewer main. Third quarter sewer cleaning maintenance complete.

**Pump Station** – All four pump stations are operating without issue.
