- Proof of Social Security numbers for all household members
- Birth dates for you, spouse, and dependents
- Complete copy of last year's tax return, including all source papers.
- All tax forms, including but not limited to: W-2, 1098, and 1099
- Information for other income
- Information for all deductions/credits
- Personal check showing bank account and routing numbers (if direct deposit or debit is requested).
