What is Renters' Rebate? It is a reimbursement program for CT renters age 65 or older or totally disabled, or whose income does not exceed certain limits. The rebate amount is calculated using a graduated income scale based on the rental amount and utility payments, excluding cable and telephone, that were made in the previous year.
