Energy Assistance

CT Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is a program that helps people having difficulty paying the cost of heating their homes. Winter heating assistance pays for a household's primary heating source. Through an intake and assessment process, Energy Assistance staff determine how its services can best help lower energy costs.

Eligibility is based on household size and gross annual income, or categorical eligibility. Families or individuals with a gross annual income at or below 60% of the State Median Income can qualify (see chart). Applications for the Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) for the 2023-2024 season began on September 1, 2023

Operation Fuel

Operation Fuel is a private, non-profit statewide program designed to provide one-time emergency energy assistance to those households who are in crisis and whose income is at or below <u>75% of</u> the State Median Income (see chart). If you do not qualify for CEAP, you may still qualify for help from Operation Fuel.

Programs through Eversource

Eversource offers programs to help as well if income falls below 60% of the state median income. For more information or to enroll in a program, call Eversource at 800-286-2828.

Winter Protection Plan

Protection from Shutoff for Hardship Customers; Service can not be shut off between November $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ and May $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st.}}$

Medical Protection

Medical protection can be applied for if anyone in your home is seriously ill or has a life-threatening situation, and you are facing having your natural gas or electrical service shut off.

Weatherization Assistance

The weatherization Assistance Program provides comprehensive weatherproofing to the households of eligible clients to make their homes more cost effective and reduce their heating costs. CEAP clients are eligible for the Weatherization Program. This program is administered through New Opportunities, Inc. Please include your name, address, and phone to ensure accurate information is sent to you.

Income-Eligible Home Energy Solutions[™] in Connecticut

If you meet income requirements, you may qualify for no-cost home weatherization service that include:

- Important safety tests on your furnace or boiler
- Weatherization including sealing drafts and air leaks
- Water saving measures like low-flow shower heads and faucet aerators
- Energy-efficient LEDs to replace incandescent bulbs
- An easy-to-read Home Energy Solutions Income Eligible workbook, which includes the results of the tests performed and additional energy-saving tips

Additional upgrade opportunities

Depending on your home's existing conditions and the efficiency measures recommended during the initial home visit, you may also qualify for additional discounted upgrades such as:

- Insulation
- Water heaters
- Heating equipment
- Windows
- Refrigerator and/or freezer rebates or vouchers
